Allocation Notices

Anyone receiving service from Webster-Calhoun Cooperative Telephone Association during the year of 2017 can expect to receive an allocation notice in June.

Profits from the cooperative are allocated back to members based upon that member's usage during that year. These funds are set aside in your name until the Board of Directors approves retirement of these funds. In the meantime these profits are reinvested into the cooperative operations. Capital Credits are an important benefit of your cooperative membership.

Phillip DeCastro, owner of The Drill Barbershop in Gowrie, opened his shop about 3 ½ years ago.
