Allocation Notices

Anyone receiving service from Webster-Calhoun Cooperative Telephone Association during the year of 2018 can expect to receive an allocation notice in June.

Profits from the cooperative are allocated back to members based upon that member's usage during that year. These funds are set aside in your name until the Board of Directors approves retirement of these funds. In the meantime these profits are reinvested into the cooperative operations. Capital Credits are an important benefit of your cooperative membership.

International Call Blocking

As a way to help protect customers from International toll fraud, WCCTA defaults all customers to block any International calling. If you wish to dial Internationally please contact our office at 515-352-3151 to remove the block.

Adding and removing the International calling block is free and adds another layer of protection for you. Not sure about your account? Check the detail under the phone number on the billing statement to see if International calling is allowed on your account.
